

COURSE INTRODUCTION

Enable newcomers with no working knowledge or skills to function in a travel related sales and customer service business anywhere in the world.

The student will also get familiarized with the industry codes, terminologies, regulations. The Air Fares and Ticketing subject would enable them to understand basic fare construction principles and checks, interpret electronic flight coupons, Issue e-tickets, and Describe the BSP System, Identify credit card payment processes. The student will be familiar with visa and health requirements, as well as tour programme.

The course requires, about 180 hours of intensive study.

On successful completion, you would be entitled an IATA/UFTAA International Travel & Tourism Foundation Diploma and will be entitled to add the designation "DTTF", after your name.
